#### Tasting notes

Ruby red color. Aromas of matured red and black fruit, such as sour cherry and plum, in a black pepper background. Medium body, softened tannins and long after taste.

#### The vineyard

Location: Santorini  
Altitude: Up to 400 meters  
Age of vines: 40 – 60 years  
Pruning method: "Kouloura" (basket-shaped)  
Planting density: 2,000-2,300 vines/ha  
Yield/ha: 2,000 kg

#### Winemaking

Sun drying of the grapes for 1-2 days before the classic red vinification.

Maturation: 24 months in medium toasted 225Lt French oak barrels of 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> use.

Limited production: 12.000 bottles
